Luau Kalamaku: Adult Pricing From \$99 (Pre-book & Save \$10)

If you only experience one thing in Hawaii, make sure you don't miss this spectacular extravaganza. Graceful Hula dancers, fire poi ball twirlers, traditional fire knife dancing and a vivid storyteller come together for this once-in-a-lifetime authentic experience. It's all happening in the historic sugar plantation of Kilohana. You'll even get to gather around an imu pit. Trust us, you've never seen a pig roasting like this before. And the buffet of local delicacies and desserts is so lavish; you'd think that was

the show. It's a real feast for your eyes and your belly. Note: Must be at least 21 years of age and provide a valid ID to consume alcohol.



Journey To Waimea Canyon: Adult Pricing From \$55

Discover the breathtaking gorge in the heart of Kauai, Waimea Canyon, often called the 'Grand Canyon of the Pacific.' Departing from Nawiliwili pier, you'll drive through the 'tunnel of trees' to the south coast, passing the beautiful area of Koloa. While continuing along the island's one main highway, enjoy views of Kauai's many distinctive terrains and the small villages and island landmarks. The centerpiece of your trip, Waimea Canyon, greets you with a spectacular view: an array of rainbow colors created by the reds

and browns of exposed volcanic rock, mingled with the blues and greens of lush tropical vegetation. This magnificent canyon in the heart of Kauai is 10 miles long, one mile wide and 3,400 feet deep. It possesses a beauty all its own. Bring a camera to capture the spectacular beauty of this natural work of art. It's an experience to treasure. Note: There are about 30 steps at the lookout.



Na Pali Explorer: Adult Pricing From \$189

The Na Pali Explorer, the original Na Pali ocean expedition, takes you to the base of mystical 4,000-foot-high sea cliffs. You'll be dwarfed by their sheer majesty and color. Sea caves and cascading waterfalls are scattered along this huge green stretch of remote rainforest coastline. The Captain and crew will provide narration on the history and mythology of the area before you take a plunge and begin to snorkel the crystal-clear waters teeming with marine life. You may even spot dolphins! Finally, enjoy a

deli-style lunch onboard before returning to your ship. Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age. Wear a swimsuit and bring a towel. This voyage may be bumpy, so it's not recommended for pregnant women, those with bad backs, heart conditions, or who suffer from sea sickness. Some guests may be assigned to sit on the pontoon part (inflated side of vessel) of the vessel.
